Applications are accepted twice a year, on October 1st and February 15th. **(The deadline is February 1st for students who will graduate in May.)**

- 2. Students may NOT declare a Spanish Major and a Spanish Minor.**
- 3. Credits applied toward a Spanish minor may not also count toward the completion of a major.**
